- **Knowledge** of frontend development using e.g., html, CSS and JavaScript as well as web development frameworks such as Angular

You will be tasked with:

- Making presentation and navigation of Tableau dashboards pleasing and intuitive
- Delivering customized Tableau visualizations for clients following a well-defined set of requirements from several stakeholders within both business and technical domains
- Maintaining Tableau workbooks and documenting them thoroughly
- Optimizing Tableau dashboard performance to achieve the best possible level of interaction in Tableau Online
- Collaborate with a backend team to determine the optimal structure and data for you to create the best possible Tableau visualizations
- Expanding your knowledge of Alteryx in order to bring you closer to a “full-stack” role within an Alteryx/Tableau setting
